DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From San Antonio/downtown Austin: Take IH 35 Northbound to Exit 240B (US 183 North). Take US 183 North for 38.6 Miles (portions toll) to County Road 221. Turn East (right) onto County Road 221 – continue ½ mile to pasture gate on right

From Houston: Take US 71 or US 290 Westbound. Just before you reach Austin, Take TX-130 Toll North (Continue on Tx-130 N for 24 mi if coming from US-290, or 36 mi. if coming from US-71). Take Exit towards TX 195 North (Florence/Killeen). Turn Left (North) over Freeway onto TX 195 and continue 14.4 mi – ****NEW** - Keep on Freeway – do NOT take Florence Business exit. Take Lampasas, HWY 138 exit -** turn left (W) over freeway onto Hwy.138 towards Lampasas–continue 7 miles to US 183 (dead end). Turn South (left) onto US 183 towards Austin – continue ¼ mile to County Road 221. Turn East (left) onto County Road 221 – continue ½ mile to gate on right

From Dallas/Ft.Worth: Take IH 35 Southbound to Exit 293A Turn right (W) onto Hwy. 190 towards Killeen – continue 18 miles to Hwy. 195 exit. Turn left (S) onto Hwy. 195 towards Florence – continue 19.5 miles to Hwy. 138. ****NEW** - Keep on Freeway – do NOT take Florence Business exit. Take Lampasas, HWY 138 exit.** Continue onto Hwy.138 towards Lampasas–approx.. 7 miles to US 183 (dead end) Turn South (left) onto US 183 towards Austin – continue ¼ mile to County Road 221. Turn East (left) onto County Road 221 – continue ½ mile to gate on right

BEST IN FIELD WILL BE OFFERED

ELIGIBLE HOUNDS

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Basenjis, Borzois, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Salukis, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Scottish Deerhounds, and Whippets that are one year of age or older, that have been registered with the AKC, or part of an AKC-registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside of the USA and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and is registered with that registry, or that have been granted an ILP or PAL, are eligible to participate. Hounds may not be entered as "registration pending" or "PAL" pending. Breed disqualifications apply.

Azawakhs, Norrbottenspets, Peruvian Inca Orchids, Portuguese Podengos (Pequeno, Medio & Grande), Sloughis and Thai Ridgebacks 1 year of age or older, that have been recorded with the Foundation Stock Service (FSS), or that have been granted a Purebred Alternate Listing (PAL) or an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) are eligible to enter lure coursing tests and trial for Suffix titles (junior, senior and master courser) but are not eligible for championship points, and are not eligible to run in Best in Field. Italian Greyhounds are not eligible to run in Best in Field.

TESTS & STAKES OFFERED

JUNIOR COURSER TEST: Open to all hounds of an eligible breed. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge assigned to one test and a second certification from a different judge assigned to another test, stating that the hound completed a 600-yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. It is strongly recommended that hounds that pass their JC test should be practiced with other hounds before being entered in the Open Stake to ensure absence of aggression on the field.

QUALIFIED COURSER TEST: A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed—or another breed with a similar running style—(Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. It is strongly recommended that every Qualifying Hound have been run previously alone and that to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practices with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds in competition is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

OPEN STAKE (trial): Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

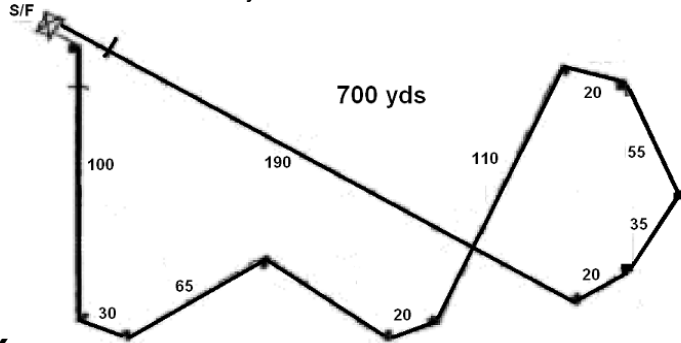
SPECIALS STAKE (trial) : Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles. Qualifying scores earned from the Specials Stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title.

OPEN VETERAN STAKE (trial): Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed’s parent club – 6 years of age; except Irish Wolfhounds = 5 years, and Afghans, Rhodesian Ridgebacks and Whippets = 7 years. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title.

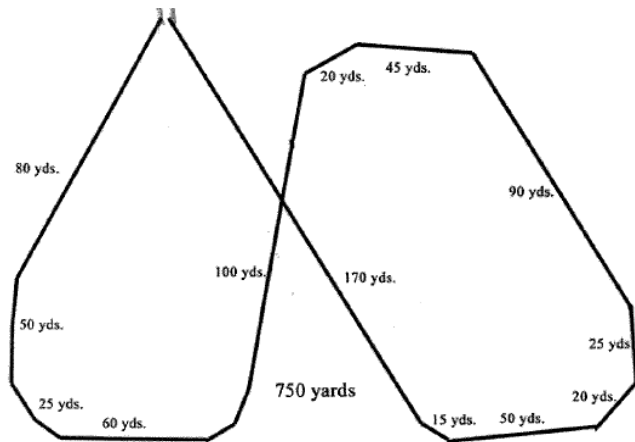
SINGLES STAKE (trial) : Non-titling stake, open to all breeds eligible to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Hounds who have been disqualified are eligible to enter. A hound running alone shall receive a score and placement determined by the scores. Singles Stake entries from all breeds shall be combined to determine placements (1st - 5th). Winner of Singles Stake is not eligible to run in Best in Field.

COURSE PLANS

Course will be reversed for finals. Run-offs and BIF Course direction will be determined at the judge’s decision. AHCoA reserves the right to alter the course as required by weather or field conditions on the day of the trial.

WHAT AKC TITLES CAN MY HOUND EARN FROM COMPETITION?

THE SENIOR COURSER (SC). (Suffix title). AKC recognizes hounds who are eligible for the open stake and who have received qualifying scores at four (4) AKC licensed or member trials, under three different judges. Each of the qualifying scores must be earned in a run with at least one other hound.

THE MASTER COURSER (MC). (Suffix title). AKC will award this to hounds that have acquired the Senior Courser title and that have earned an additional twenty-five (25) qualifying scores (with competition) in either the Open, Veteran, or Specials stake at AKC licensed or member club lure coursing trials.

THE FIELD CHAMPIONSHIP (FC). (Prefix title). To be called a Field Champion, a hound must obtain fifteen (15) championship points, including two major wins. Major wins must be won under two different judges, and at least one point must be earned in competition with a hound of the same breed. A major is a first placement of three, four, or five points according to the Schedule of Points by Breed. A Field Champion may be designated as “Dual Champion (DC)” if it has also been recorded as a Show Champion.

THE LURE COURSER EXCELLENT (LCX), (Suffix title). Any dog that has earned the title of Field Champion and has earned 45 additional championship points from the Specials or Veterans Stake, shall be awarded the suffix title of Lure Courser Excellent (LCX). Each time a hound accrues an additional 45 championship points, it would be eligible to receive the next title level (LCX II, LCX III, LCX IV, etc.)

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

- The pasture field has no amenities or shade available. Please ensure the comfort of you and your hounds by bringing your own portable shade/shelter and water.
- Portable restrooms will be made available.
- Lunch, drinks and snacks will be made available by AHCoA both Saturday and Sunday. Please make an appropriate donation for your participation.
- All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.
- Each hound requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- No hound may enter more than one stake.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.
- Any entry fees submitted and accepted with entries will be refunded in full if the withdrawal of said entries is requested by the hound's owner or agent prior to the closing deadline for Entries. Requests must be made either in person to the FTS or by time-stamped email to the FTS or by direct contact (phone or in person) with the FTS. No refunds for any entry fees will be returned after the closing of entries unless the entered hound upon inspection is lame or in season.
- Substitution of hounds will be accepted at the time of roll call/inspection. Once inspection is complete, no further substitution will be allowable.
- All hounds to be inspected for entry in the AKC JC or QC Test(s) and/or Trials must be presented WITHOUT TAPE, BANDAGES or WRAPPING on the toes, feet, or legs. Committee members may request that cold-weather coverings such as blankets, coats and pajamas be removed from hounds under inspection.
- Field Committee Members, Volunteer Trial Workers and Pre-Entered Competitors may have their hounds inspected prior to the designated inspection time by the full inspection committee.
- Hounds not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched and entry fees will not be refunded
- Stakes will be split if sufficient entries are present in any one stake at the time of the draw for two or more 5-point majors. Splitting of stakes will be held publicly and at the FTS desk.
- Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be refused entry and, if presented at inspection, will be refunded entry fees.
- Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds may not be entered in any stake.
- Spayed or neutered hounds may be entered.
- Dogs that have been disqualified by a judge for being aggressive to another dog while coursing will be eligible to participate in Singles Stakes. Dogs disqualified by an event committee are not allowed to participate in Single Stakes
- The lure will consist of plastic contrasting in color with the immediate field environment.
- Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.
