TESTS & STAKES OFFERED

Junior Courser Test

Open to all hounds of an eligible breed. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge assigned to one test and a second certification from a different judge assigned to another test, stating that the hound completed a 600-yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED that Hounds that pass their JC test SHOULD be practiced with other hounds before being entered in Open Stake to ensure absence of aggression on the field.

Qualified Courser (QC) Certificate (test)

Open to a hound of an eligible breed, at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound), running with another hound of the same breed – or another breed with a similar running style (Testing Hound) - shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. Upon successful completion of the Qualified Courser test, the judge completes a certificate and awards it to the handler. This certificate must be submitted to the host club with the hound's first entry in an Open Stake. The certificate must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED that every qualifying Hound have been run previously alone and that to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practices with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds in competition is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

Open Stake

Open to a hound of an eligible breed who has obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have ran in the Open Class prior to January 1, 2010. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). The ASFA or CKC Field Champion certificate must accompany the entry to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy will be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship Title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

Specials Stake

Open to a hound of an eligible breed who has earned their AKC Field Championship title. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles. Qualifying scores earned from the Specials Stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title. awarded from this stake.

Veteran Stake

Open to a hound of an eligible breed who eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club – 6 years of age; except Irish Wolfhounds – 5 years, and Whippets - 7 years. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent Title.

Note: Hounds who have received a disqualification at an AKC trial are ineligible to compete until recertified.

BEST IN FIELD WILL BE OFFERED

Italian Greyhounds are not eligible to compete for Best in Field.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY

Afghan Hounds, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Italian Greyhounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, and Whippets. All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC or have been granted an ILP by the AKC.

Effective January 1, 2008: Azawakh, Portuguese Podengo, Thai Ridgeback and Sloughis, 1 year of age or older, that have been recorded with the Foundation Stock Service (FSS), or that have been granted and Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) are eligible to enter lure coursing tests and trial for junior, senior and master courser titles but are not eligible for championship points, and are not eligible to run in Best in Field.

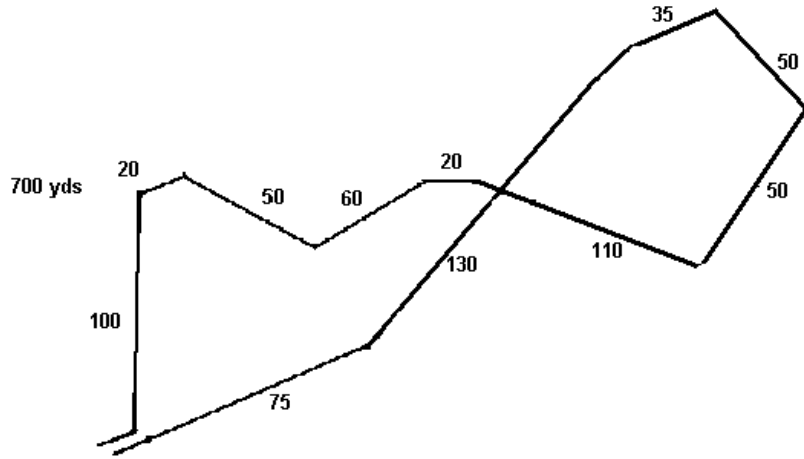

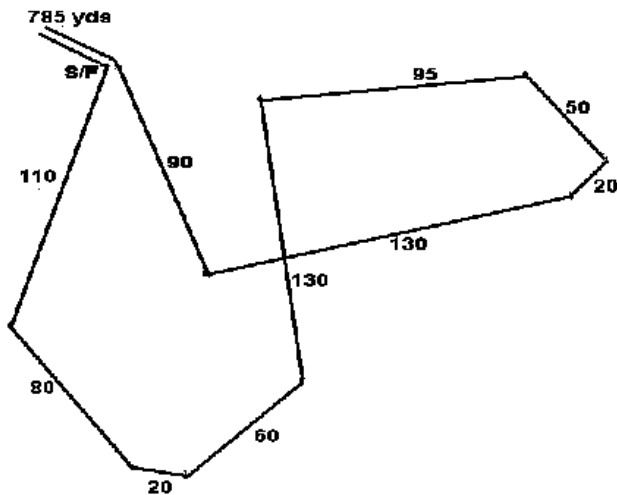

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial
- Stakes will be split by public random draw if the entry in any one stake is sufficient to hold two or more five point majors.
- Hounds not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched and entry fees will not be refunded.
- No hound may enter more than one stake.
- All Hounds will be checked for breed disqualifications.
- Altered or neutered hounds may compete. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are NOT eligible to compete.
- Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused. Entry fees for hounds excused during inspection will be refunded.
- Hounds not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period, and entry fees will not be refunded.
- Electrical-powered, continuous loop lure machine will be used with back-up equipment available.
- The lure will consist of plastic contrasting in color with the immediate field environment
- Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled.
- A fee of \$32 will be assessed for any returned checks.
- There will be a \$5 fine for any loose hound on the field that is not part of the course in progress.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC, AHCoA, and/or any Hound(s) or other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.
- The AHCoA and Double-H Ranch assume no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during or after these trials.
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs.
- Fun Runs will be offered on Saturday only after both test and trial competitions are complete and as time and daylight permits.
